8 Keya no Oto

Keya no Oto is the largest basaltic cave of Japan located in the west of Itoshima. The cave is 90m in depth, 2 to 10m in width and 8m in height from the sea level. The view of the cave is spectacular where you can pay a visit by riding on a boat from the local harbor. You can also find this place from the summit of Mt. Tateshi. Be prepared to leave some unforgettable memories!
