

Mt. Kaya

Kaya-san (365m), located near Chikuzen maebaru station and Itoshima's best oyster huts are one of the best hiking places to go for beginner-intermediate hikers. Kaya-san is a short day hike that takes about 2 to 3 hours yet offers a great view at the summit where you can see the a panoramic view from Keya no Oto all the way to Fukuoka Tower.
